« The Nungesser relay race: class's major activity »

The Combined Arms School

The Combined Arms School is tasked with the training of young officers who were already serving within the French Army ranks as non-commissioned officers or privates.

It is a part of the Saint-Cyr Coëtquidan schools which count also the Special Military School of Saint-Cyr. These schools' facilities are established in the town of Guer, in the region of Morbihan, in Brittany.

The Combined Arms School offers a two-year course to the cadets who are to be in charge of operational units from the French Army as soon as they graduate. Later, they are intended to assume major roles in terms of leadership, planning and decision within the Army, the Department of Defense or in multinational staffs.

On July 25th 2015, the Combined Arms School's 54th class took the name of « Class Lieutenant Charles Nungesser ». This year is the opportunity for the 2nd Lieutenants of the class to help people discover this famous pilot and the class through large-scale projects.

The Nungesser relay race

This unique event consists in a relay race along the World War I front line, the route matching aerials victory sites of the class's Patron. The 600-kilometer-itinerary is likely to be completed in 48 hours, from May 5th to 7th 2016.

The route goes from Nancy to Dunkerque and the Unknown Soldier's Flame, taken from the Arc de Triomphe, is to be carried all along the way. The activity consists in both a sporting event and a more cultural aspect which hinges on the discovery of famous World War I historic sites.

The first and last steps of the race are to be opened to anyone who would like to participate. The funds gathered by the event are to be offered to the association « Terre Fraternité », which goal is to improve the medical care and the living conditions of the war-wounded.

During the last 15 kilometers, the 2nd Lieutenants would run with high-ranked civil servants and military personnel, corporate delegations and every volunteer who would like to take part to the event.
